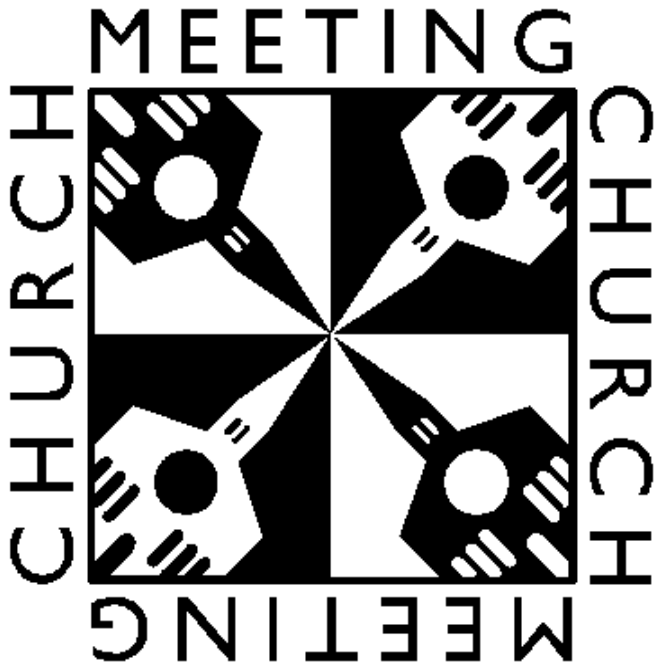


Voter's Meetings At Christ The Lord Lutheran Church



Voter's meetings are regularly conducted throughout the year. Usually, a voter's meeting is held each quarter. Occasionally, special voter's meetings are called.

Our congregation's constitution states the general purpose for these meetings: *The meetings shall give the voters of this congregation the opportunity to hear, discuss and take necessary action in matters pertaining to the welfare of this congregation and of the church at large.*

- Quarterly meetings are usually held on the first Sunday of the month in: February (annual meeting), May, August and November. We normally begin these meetings at 9:15 a.m. Copies of the agenda and the reports are usually made available the Sunday before.
- All confirmed members are welcome to attend and participate in a voter's meeting. ***We especially encourage our men to attend since they have voting / leadership responsibilities and privileges.***
- The opinion of our women matters! Before a vote is taken, the men first talk to their wives and other women present without a husband.
